### Buyer Beware

It is advised that homeowners receive more than one bid, check ratings of a company with the better business bureau and see references from a contractor before you have any work done on your home.

If you have had problems with a specific company you can report it Town Hall and the Better Business Bureau.

All contractors must have a current transient license through the Town of Kiowa.

Elbert County has teamed up with the 911 Authority board, Fire Departments and local Towns to implement CodeRed, an emergency notification system via phone, a service FREE to Elbert County residents. There are three components to this system:

1. Reverse Emergency Notification calls
2. Weather Warning Notification calls
3. Emergency Management Community updates via email and texting

### Shelter in Place for Tornado... What does it mean?

Let's take a look at "Shelter in Place". With the possibility of tornado, be in the know.

Shelter in place means to seek immediate shelter and remain there during an emergency event. Especially if a tornado is imminent and evacuation is not possible or there is not a better place to be. You should always know how to shelter in place in your home or work place in the event of hazardous weather.

Here are a few tips to remember if you get "Warning" of hazardous weather in your area.

- Move to the basement of the location your in
- Move to an interior room with now windows, or a hallway on the floor
- Move to an interior stairwell if your rooms have windows
- Stay in the center of the room away from doors and windows
- Stay put! Until the danger has passed
- Place a mattress over your body

Get in the bath Tub and throw a couch cushion over you

Now that you are thinking about this location in your home; What about taking some items with you and store in that location so you can use in an emergency. Here are some tips.

- Flashlight
- Heavy Blanket for protection of falling debris
- Weather radio
- Water/food
- First Aid Kit

Cell Phone

Remember that it is not always safe to leave your location when storms have arrived. Plan to know your locations in home or office. Find the best location and stay there. Be sure to share this message with a friend or family member. Let's work to get everyone thinking about safety at home or work when the threat of storms is in your area.

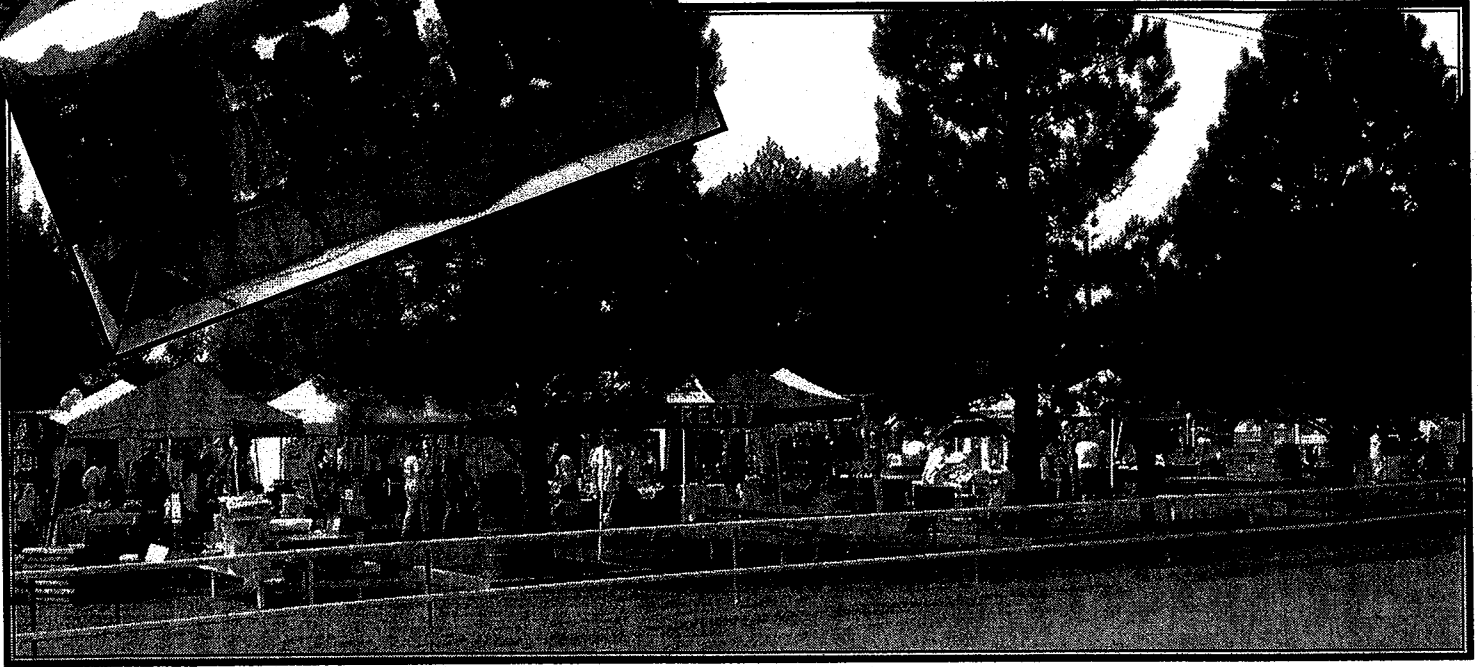

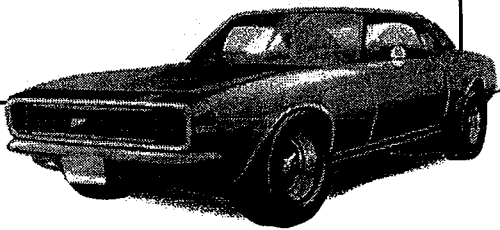
